Nakimuli-Mpungu et al. (p.1349) compared HIV-positive and -negative adult patients in Uganda who presented with first-episode acute mania. Those with positive serostatus were found to be older on average and more likely to be female than their seronegative counterparts. Clinically, the HIV-positive patients had more manic symptoms, were more disruptive and overtalkative, and had higher rates of paranoid delusions and visual and auditory hallucinations. Interestingly, about half of those with HIV infection had been unaware of their serostatus before they were evaluated for mania. Images were provided by Etheldreda Nakimuli-Mpungu.
