The quality of sibling relationships in childhood may contribute to the risk of depression in adult life. In this issue, Waldinger et al. (p. 949), studying subjects over several decades, found that distant or destructive relationships with siblings before age 20 predicted depression and frequency of mood-altering drugs by age 50. The authors speculate that positive sibling relationships may enhance the capacity to relate well with peers, which is important in both occupational and social functioning.
