## Cover

For the first time in a single study, similarities and differences between seasonal and non-seasonal depression were examined by Sullivan and Payne (p. 1663). In a sample of 93 college students, seasonal affective disorder was found to be substantially more prevalent than major depressive disorder. Similar impairments in attention and memory retrieval were seen in the two disorders, and women were more likely to meet criteria for both
