Since 1995, Poudre Valley Hospital in Fort Collins, Colorado, has been

effectively providing services to a community of primarily elderly, chronically ill individuals perpetually caught in the gaps between acute and end-of-life services. By emphasizing timely access to health-maximizing services, this community case managers program documented an impressive 81 reduction in financial losses to the organization during 2006 for emergency and inpatient services provided to a specific sample from this population.

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
