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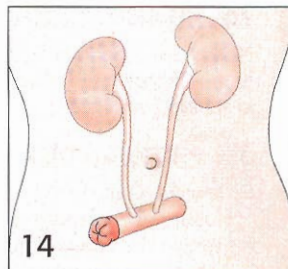
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Because erythromycin increases the number and force of gastric contractions, it may be prescribed to treat gastroparesis, p. 20.
